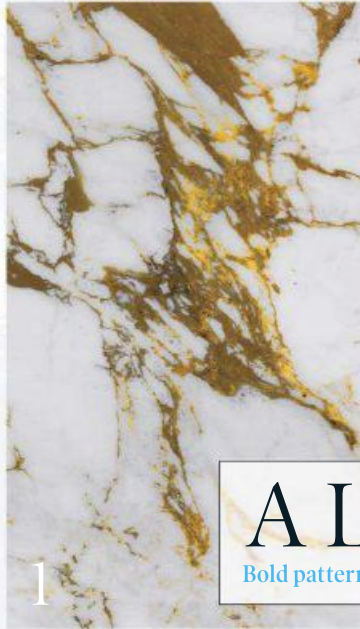

Bold patterns and striking colors add zest to the standard white kitchen.



1 Electric Marble is Sicis's reinterpretation of the sought-after Calacatta stone. A polymer film infused with metallics is pressed between two layers of clear glass, resulting in an explosion of neon. Sold as a slab or cut to size. *From \$200 per sq. ft. sicis.com*

2 Crafted for beauty and performance, Bertazzoni's Professional Series 48" dual-fuel range has a 19,000-BTU burner and dual horizontal convection. Available in six finishes. *\$8,750. bertazzoni.com*

3 Once again, Dolce & Gabbana has partnered with Smeg to surround a fridge with an artful story. This year, artist
